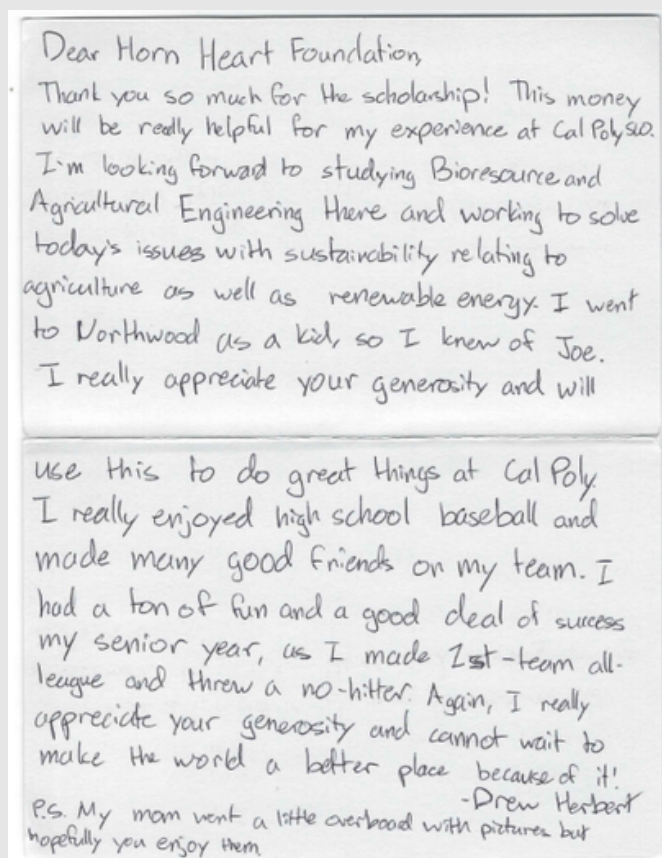
CELEBRATING THE CLASS OF 2026

OPENING DOORS THROUGH VOLLEYBALL



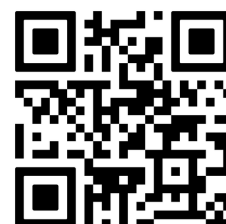
